Roberto grew up in Rome, where he was first introduced to folk music and dance, eventually taking part in performances and teaching dance classes. He subsequently studied folk dance throughout Europe, Israel, and North America.

He is the founder of Folk Atelier Reggio Emilia (FARE), devoted to the development and conservation of folk dance heritage. As director of FARE, he is in charge of organizing and conducting folk dance classes, workshops with Italian and foreign specialists, and organizing the performing sector, staging various performances and dance gathering.

Roberto currently organizes two dance camps in Europe: Balkanot and Camp Yofi. He also conducts workshops and seminars throughout Europe, the United States, Canada, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Singapore and Japan.
